The Every Child Matters policy and subsequent workforce reform agenda is aimed at ensuring that all children in England have the best possible life chances and are in receipt of joined up, appropriate and accessible services when needed. Research has much to offer this effort in terms of demonstrating both what happens to children when professionals do not form a "team around the child" and what happens when they do.

This session will highlight messages from research including the National Evaluation of the Children's Fund that Maggie was involved with and use case studies and discussion to further explore knowledge and understanding of this important subject.

Maggie McCutcheon joined the University of Bedfordshire as Senior Lecturer in 2006. Prior to this she was at Birmingham University, where she was a senior researcher with the National Evaluation of the Children's Fund.
